More than 250,000 Jews in Central Europe alone converted to Christianity in the 19th century.¹

The Torah is unique in being the only Holy Book of a religion that was revealed publicly for all to see. Those of all other religions were revealed to just a few privileged individuals. The Torah was revealed to three million or so Jews 3,319 years ago in a public place, Mount Sinai, for all to witness.²

When Rabbi Shimshon Raphael Hirsch (a 19th-century German rabbi and famous Torah commentator) was an old man, his students were shocked to see him heading for the Alps. "Why is the Rabbi taking time from studying Torah to go hiking?" they asked. "I'm approaching the end of my life," he responded, and it won't be long before my soul goes to the next world. When I get there, the Almighty will ask me, 'So, Shimshon, what do you think of My Alps?' What will I say if I never saw the beautiful mountains that He put here for us to enjoy?"⁴

The Torah is often critical of the Jews. It calls them stiff-necked and portrays their every shortcoming and flaw. Virtually every history book of ancient civilizations exaggerates the people's virtues and accomplishments and omits their failings, except for the Torah. Why should the Jews willingly appropriate a book that portrays them in such a negative light unless there was a divine imperative to do so?⁵
